Professor Duncan Fairgrieve is an academic & lawyer practising as a French avocat and English barrister. He holds contemporaneously academic positions at the <u>Université de Paris Dauphine PSL</u>, where he is Professor of Comparative Law, and the British Institute of International and Comparative Law, London, where he is Senior Research Fellow in Comparative Law and Director of the <u>Product Liability Forum at the Institute</u>.

In the academic world, Duncan Fairgrieve is a leading comparative lawyer, with research interests spanning comparative, European and international law. He has published many books and articles in leading journals worldwide, in both English and French, including over 20 authored or edited books and numerous articles on comparative law topics. He edited the festschrifts for Lord Slynn, and Lord Bingham. He was educated at King's College London, Oxford University and the Sorbonne, Paris.

Duncan Fairgrieve practises as a barrister from <u>1 Crown Office Row in London</u>, and as a French avocat from <u>49 boulevard de Courcelles</u>, <u>Paris</u>. He has an international & cross-border practice covering both transactions and dispute resolution with particular expertise in European and international law. He has appeared in cases before all major jurisdictions in England and France, including the English Court of Appeal and the Uk Supreme Court, and the French Court of Appeal.
